

## How to find the Suspicion of Cancer DAP:

The SoC DAP is located on the 3rd floor of the Rotary Place Building on the Royal Victoria Regional Health Centre Campus. This building is separate from the Royal Victoria Hospital.

**From Highway 400 North:** Exit Duckworth Street and continue straight through the lights onto Georgian Drive.

**From Highway 400 South:** Exit at Duckworth and turn left on Duckworth St. and left again at the lights onto Georgian Drive.

**From Georgian Drive:** Proceed along Georgian Drive past the main hospital entrance, turn right onto Gallie Court (#1 below) (Tim Hortons is at the corner), Rotary Place is on your immediate right on Gallie Court. Park in the visitor parking lot #2 below).

**Locating the Suspicion of Cancer DAP:** After entering the Rotary Place building, take the elevator to Level 3. The Suspicion of Cancer DAP is located in the Family Medicine Clinic. See reception upon arriving for your appointment.

## *What is the Suspicion of Cancer DAP?*

The Suspicion of Cancer Diagnostic Assessment Program (SoC DAP) is a clinic where patients with a suspicion of cancer can be supported with further testing to rule out or to confirm if they have cancer. The clinic will coordinate testing, care, and referrals needed to follow-up on the suspicion of cancer.

## *Why have I been referred?*

You have been referred to the SoC DAP because your Physician would like order further testing to follow-up on a suspicion of cancer. The DAP team will meet with you and arrange the necessary tests.

## *What happens next?*

1. You will receive a phone call from the program's clerical navigator, who will:
  - provide you with the date and time of your appointment
  - provide the dates and times for planned tests and procedures
2. Attend your scheduled SoC DAP appointment
3. Complete your scheduled tests and necessary procedures
4. Return to the SoC DAP to review the test results and determine next steps with the doctor

## *What can I expect?*

During your Suspicion of Cancer DAP appointment, a Physician will:

- Perform a physical exam
- Assess your symptoms
- Refer you to tests and procedures to find out if you have cancer
- Answer any questions you may have

## *What do I need to bring?*

- Ontario Health Card
- List of current medications, vitamins, herbal supplements and their doses
- List of your allergies
- Any questions or concerns you have
- A family member/friend to help you process the information
